NRCS Report: Jim reported that an office appraisal is scheduled for the week of April 23rd. The appraisal will be conducted by area staff from Rochester. It will cover all programs, administration and office functions. In previous appraisals the board and SWCD employees were visited with along with landowners. I have not received any dates or request to meet with the board or staff at this time.

Conservation Reserve program General Sign-up ends the 13th. 143 contracts are expiring, most are signing up again. Some of the environmental CRP contracts do not meet eligibility so some of the acres need to be offered in the general. According to FSA there is a proposed bill that would require a workload analysis prior to closing of an office. Not sure of the status on this or when a decision will be made. As of now the plans are to close the FSA office the end of July. All the Conservation Stewardship payments have been made 65 participants.

Environmental Quality Incentive Program sign-up ranking just ended. We have around 15 that were funded for about \$120,000. Not all practices were funded and we are awaiting additional funds.

Gave a presentation on NRCS programs and controlled drainage at a farmers meeting in New Richland. There was very good discussion and feedback from the meeting. Around 30 farmers attended.
